



Stitcher (\$400 per week/housing included):

The Stitcher is responsible for working with the Costume Shop Manager/Costume Designer in the execution of the vision of each production. Stitches and finishes all assigned costumes, cutting, measuring, assembling, building, pulling costumes and accessories under the supervision of the Costume Shop Manager.

Principal Duties and Responsibilities:

- Sewing assigned costumes by machine or hand
- Assisting in fitting, stitching, or other assigned costume duties.
- Maintaining and altering costumes as assigned
- Maintaining a clean and safe workspace.
- Assisting with Strike for each production.
- Maintaining the organization and storage of costumes/accessories.
- Report any problems with deadlines, materials, or equipment to the Shop Manager or Costume Designer.
- Follow procedures and policies of Wagon Wheel Center for the Arts.
- **Any other tasks as requested by the Costume shop Manager, the Costume Designer, or TD.**

- Demonstrated experience in machine and hand sewing techniques.
- Proficiency in commercial and industrial sewing machine operation.
- Excellent garment construction skills.
