



Wagon Wheel Center for the Arts is seeking 1 Stitcher* and 1 Stitcher/Wardrobe for its Professional Theatre holiday production of *A Christmas Carol*.**

Pay is \$500 a week plus housing and a transportation stipend.

The build of the show is November 18-December 1, 2023. The show runs December 1-December 18, 2023.

*Stitcher contract dates are November 18-December 3, 2023

**Stitcher/Wardrobe contract dates are November 18-December 19, 2023

This position will help with the alterations/minor builds of costumes working in the costume shop until the production goes into tech. At that time, it will transition over to a Wardrobe/Run Crew position, through the end of the contract.

Stitchers: must have good sewing skills, be a knowledgeable crafts-person is a plus, have some experience working with industrial sewing machines (blind stitch, serger, etc.), be well organized with the ability to work diligently under Costume Coordinator/Shop Manager. This position will require you to work closely with the Costume Coordinator/Shop Manager to execute the design of the show. This show is primarily a rental package with the majority of the job focused on alterations/minor construction. Other expectations include but are not limited to: Keeping the costume shop/stock/storage organized and cared for, pulling appropriate costumes as needed, building costumes/pieces/accessories. assisting with alterations as specified by the costume designer. or other things required to complete the design of the show.

Wardrobe run crew: Helping with quick changes, emergency repairs, and preset/strike of costumes during performances. Other duties include: Costume tracking, laundry, ensuring that the dressing rooms and laundry facilities are being kept in an orderly state, ensuring the current show needs are being accomplished and that all costumes/undergarments/shoes/accessories are in good repair for the show, must be good with children. Making repairs as needed. Doing laundry after every performance and making sure they are hung up, dry, ironed, and ready for the next show. Helping with strike, laundering, and return of costumes to stock.
