



Master Electrician (\$475 per week/housing included):

The Master Electrician is responsible for working with the Lighting Designer/Technical Director to ensure the safe and accurate realization of the light plot, hanging, circuiting, patching, cabling, focus, gels, gobos, basic maintenance and upkeep the Lighting Designers vision throughout the whole process.

Principal Duties and Responsibilities:

- Interpreting the Lighting Plot.
- Planning and managing the hang, cabling, circuiting, gels, gobos, and focus of the light plot in a safe and timely manner.
- Ordering gels, gobos, specialty items needed by the Lighting Designer.
- Maintaining the lighting equipment.
- Assisting the Scenic Department with any scenery lighting effects.
- Running light console for all performances.
- Dimmer checks.
- Working in scene shop when lighting tasks are completed.
- Ability to work and manage within a group.
- Assisting with Strike for each production.
- Maintaining the organization and storage of electrics area and lighting stock.
- Maintaining a clean and safe workspace
- Report any problems with deadlines, materials, or equipment to TD or Artistic Director.
- Follow procedures and policies of Wagon Wheel Center for the Arts.
- This job will require, bending, carrying, crawling, emptying trash, kneeling, lifting, loud noises, math, pushing/pulling, painting, twisting, working nights, sawdust, sweeping.
- **Any additional tasks as requested by the TD.**

Skills:

- Strong working knowledge of ETC lighting consoles.
- Competent wiring practical electrical units and cable repair.
- Comfortable working on ladders and at heights exceeding 12'.
- Strong working knowledge of DMX, moving fixtures, LED instruments, LED wiring, and other DMX special effect equipment.
- Strong Communication.
- Ability to be self-sufficient and self-motivated.
- Ability to prioritize and have good time management.
- Show an ability to learn and grow within the working environment, all while maintaining a healthy positive attitude
